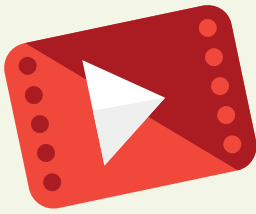

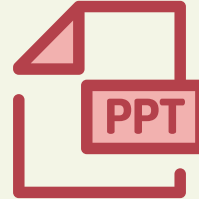

About PGP Programme

The Post Graduate Programme in Management is a two-year, full time residential programme. The first year coursework is spread over three terms. The programme fosters an overall development of the future business leaders with strong fundamentals. The curriculum is designed to give students a perfect combination of academic skills and insights into the changing business environment. It comprises core courses that explain the fundamentals of management across different functional areas.

The courses in the first year curriculum are mandatory for all the students. The first-year coursework is followed by a summer internship. The Summer Internship Programme is an integral part of the PGP Course and it bridges the gap between theory and real world dynamics. Students are required to work on an industry project with an organization for a period of eight to ten weeks.

The second year coursework is spread over the next three terms (Term IV to Term VI). The second year students are offered elective courses across different functional areas such as marketing, finance, operations, strategy, human resources and economics. The students can opt for elective courses based on their preferences, insofar as they fulfil the minimum credit requirements for the programme. The participants who successfully fulfil all the requirements of the programme are awarded the 'Post-graduate Diploma in Management'.

The organizations can start inviting applications any time after the Pre-Placement Talk (PPT) and/or confirmation of participation in the Summer Placement Process. The details of the job offer such as profile, stipend and location must be provided before applications are invited. Consequently, an invitation letter will be mailed to the organization confirming the date and time at which the Selection Process will take place. The organization is required to communicate the detailed process requirements (number of selection rounds, panels, and process specific requirements) at-least 3 days prior to the placement process.

Pre-Placement Talks

A Pre-Placement Talk (PPT) provides an excellent opportunity for candidates to gain deeper knowledge about the prospective employers. It allows an organization to take a first-hand look at the institute and the existing talent pool. The representatives get a chance to spend some quality time with the students and the faculty. The PPTs are scheduled to suit the convenience of the organization without affecting the PGP schedule.

Pre-Placements Offers

Pre-Placement offers are made by the organization to candidates who have completed a 2-month summer internship with them. The exact policy regarding PPOs is subject to the discretion of the placement committee and should be confirmed with them.


